- 2- National team capacity to adequately support the nominated athletes: maximum team size set at 20 as per criteria 6.2 b
- 3- Number of races on the program of the WORLD JUNIOR AND U23 WORLD SKI CHAMPIONSHIPS in each category
- 4- Assessment of the level of international competitiveness of athletes in each category
- 5- Potential requests of exemption of racing (at Trials) for Curtailment of Health
