- SafeSport Application Form
- Screening Disclosure Form
- NCCP Making Ethical Decisions (coaches only)
- CAC (Coaching Association of Canada) SafeSport Training
- Rule of Two online learning – (CAC)
- Driver's Abstract – required to drive athletes

Requirements do not have to be completed to apply. Successful application will be emailed instruction on how to complete them.
