1. Information and Objectives

1. This document establishes the eligibility criteria and procedures Nordiq Canada uses to select athletes for international competitions.
2. The [Team Selection, Nomination and Announcement Policy](#) guide the process for the creation of selection criteria.
3. Final decision authority for all selections is the Nordiq Canada High-Performance Director (HPD) or their designate.
4. Selection decisions may be appealed under the [Nordiq Canada Dispute Resolution and Appeals Policy](#).
 - a. Any dispute must be brought directly to the SDRCC to be heard pursuant to the Canadian Sport Dispute Resolution Code.
 - b. An athlete who wishes to appeal shall file an appeal with the SDRCC within 3 days of the nomination Synopsis and Rationale being posted to the Nordiq Canada website.
5. The Nordiq Canada HPD, or their designate, has the authority, and reserves the right to amend this document before the selection date.
6. It is each athlete's responsibility to read and understand the contents of this document and other supporting documents and policies.

2. Eligibility Criteria

1. Athletes seeking to be selected to international competitions under these Selection Criteria must, at the time of nomination, be Nordiq Canada members in good standing with a valid Canadian passport, a Nordiq Canada racing license, and a valid Canadian FIS license. In order to maintain eligibility after selection, athletes must continue to satisfy the aforementioned criteria, failing which their selection may be rescinded.
2. Athletes must meet FIS and other event [entry standards](#) for the competition(s) for which they qualified.

3. Selection Guidelines

1. Only events listed in this document are considered for selection rankings and standards.
2. Nordiq Canada is not obligated to select athletes up to the maximum number of allotted quota positions. Selection decisions will be made in consideration of the FIS nation quota, available budget, team resources, and the athlete's readiness and suitability for international competition. Even if an athlete meets the qualification criteria, they may not be selected on the basis of the aforementioned factors and/or if it is determined that participation would not align with the objectives of the team.
3. The HPD reserves the right to determine or adjust team size based on the operational budget, where doing so supports athlete health, performance readiness, and the overall competitiveness of the team.
4. In the event of a tie after the selection criteria have been applied, the athletes will be ranked by the priorities in the order they appear in the criteria. Where two or more athletes are tied within the same criterion, priority shall be given to the athlete demonstrating the greater consistency of performance during the applicable 2026–27 World Cup period.

An athlete is ranked according to the highest-priority criterion they meet, regardless of how many lower-priority criteria they also satisfy. Demonstrated consistency of performance shall be used to differentiate between athletes who qualify under the same criterion.

Consistency shall be assessed using the following factors, applied sequentially:

- a. Number of qualifying results: The number of individual World Cup results meeting or exceeding the applicable performance standard;

- b. Second-best result: The athlete's second-best individual World Cup final finish;
- c. Third-best result: The athlete's third-best individual World Cup final finish, where applicable;
- d. Average performance: The athlete's average individual World Cup final finish across their applicable World Cup results;
- e. Current performance and readiness: Current performance and performance readiness, including performance readiness testing under Section 10.5, current and historical results, current and historical testing data, and current and historical training data.

If two or more athletes remain tied after application of the above criteria, the matter shall be referred to the HPD and High-Performance Committee (HPC) for consideration under Section 8.1. Any decision as to whether an athlete may be considered for nomination shall be reached by majority consensus of the HPC.

- 5. In the event a qualifying athlete is ineligible or otherwise unable to compete, the HPD may select the next qualifying athlete for that competition.
- 6. Only qualifying race results that meet the definitions in Appendix A – Definitions will be used for selections.
- 7. All race results referred to in the selection criteria are from the 2026-27 season unless otherwise indicated.

	Where more than one athlete (i.e., a race winner) is eligible for a remaining position through the Domestic Trials, selection will be based on the athlete's overall performance at the designated trials and their demonstrated ability to contribute to the performance objectives of the 2027 World Ski Championships Team. The Selection Committee is not obligated to fill all available quota positions through the Domestic Trials.

8. Appendix A - Definitions

Definitions relevant to understanding criteria procedures:

1. **HPD discretion:** HPD discretion will only be applied in exceptional circumstances. In such circumstances, the HPD will consult with the HPC, and a decision as to whether an athlete could be considered for nomination will be reached by majority consensus. The HPD and HPC may use the following as evidence:
 - a. A performance readiness test as per section 8.5
 - b. Current and historical results
 - c. Current and historical testing data
 - d. Current and historical training data
2. **Individual Final Finish Race Result:** The final time and ranking attributed to an athlete after an entire individual event, i.e., time of day, qualification heats, or pre-qualification times are not considered individual final finish race results. An athlete must complete the race and obtain FIS points for any result to be considered valid.
3. **Team Final Finish Race Result:** The final time and ranking attributed to a team at the end of an entire team event; i.e., qualification rounds are not considered. A team must complete the race and obtain a final finish time to be considered a race result. Also see Depth of Field Team Event definition for further final finish result requirements.
4. **Depth of Field Team Event:** For a final finish race result to be achieved, the team must be in the top half of the field, including all teams that start the event; i.e., teams that are lapped out, disqualified or not permitted to start will count towards the total field size. Top half means a final placing equal to or better than the mathematical ceiling of 50% of all teams that start the event.
5. **Performance Readiness Test:** The performance readiness test will consist of a controlled performance such as a competition or observed test or trial. The athlete will be given reasonable notice of the date of the test or trial, considering the circumstances of the athlete's illness or injury.
 - a. Tests may also include, but are not limited to, physiotherapy assessment, medical assessment/clearance and time trial/race results to confirm health and readiness to compete at a high-performance level.
 - b. The objective of a performance readiness test shall be to determine whether it is more likely than not that the athlete will be ready to return to competition at their normal state of health and at the level of performance that would have otherwise justified their nomination to the international competition trip. When making any of the determinations, the HPD may consult with the IST Lead, Nordiq Canada team doctor, the HPC or any other individual with relevant expertise.
 - c. If an athlete is required to undergo a performance readiness test as described above, the athlete will not be nominated to the competition trip team until they have undergone the test and until the HPD is satisfied that the athlete will return to their normal state of health and at the level of performance that would have otherwise justified their nomination to the competition trip team.
