

2026-27 NATIONAL SKI TEAM SELECTIONS

Congratulations to the athletes who have been selected to the National Ski Team based on the criteria outlined in the Nordiq Canada [2026-27 National Ski Team Selection Criteria – OLY](#). All nominations were reviewed and supported by the High-Performance Committee.

Selection Rationale

- The goal of the NST selection criteria is to select athletes who are following the performance pathway progression in relation to global competitors to achieve podium success at the Olympic Winter Games and World Ski Championships.
- Team criteria descriptions are abbreviated versions of the criteria. Selection was completed using the full criteria description within the selection documents.
- Athletes must meet all eligibility requirements in the NST carding selection criteria to be selected or nominated.
