New for 2020, this fun event is a great way for young skiers between 5 and 12 years of age to put their skills to the test tackling a range of obstacles on the same course the professional athletes raced around just hours earlier! The entry fee for this event is \$20 (plus taxes and service fees). Online registration opens tomorrow, Tuesday January 21, at worldcupccquebec.com. Only a limited number of entries are available, so don't miss your chance to register for this exciting new event!

Mini cross-country athletes can look forward to living their dream of following in the ski tracks of their World Cup idols on Saturday, March 14 and Sunday, March 15, from 3:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. Entrants will each receive an official bib and attend a pre-event preparation meeting and ice-breaker activity. There will be a sprint-style start, (with six skiers per corral and 5-10 minutes between corrals). The event will be commentated by none other than the official World Cup commentator. After the event, all entrants will receive an official medal and post-event snack and will be invited to an autograph-signing session with the Canadian World Cup athletes. Course and start time details based on age group will be sent out closer to the event.

Trainers wishing to obtain accreditation to cheer young skiers in this fun challenge can apply starting tomorrow by submitting their NCCP certification number through the registration platform parents and guardians will use to sign their children up for the event.
