

## **Nordiq Canada Job Description**

National Team World Cup Coach

### **Summary**

Reporting to the HPD, the National Team World Cup Coach is responsible for leading the technical delivery and alignment of Senior National Ski Team (Senior NST) programs in order to achieve podium performances at Olympic Games and FIS World Championships. The National Team World Cup Coach will have the responsibility to plan, coordinate and monitor the training and competition of NST athletes in line with Nordiq Canada's collective goals and will support alignment of Canada's high performance podium pathway.

The National Team Coach will work closely with the National Team NextGen Coach to align NextGen (Junior and U23) programming to ensure consistency in programming, coaching, and preparation of athletes.

### **Duties and Responsibilities**

- Plan, coordinate and monitor the training, race preparation and competition of Senior NST athletes ensuring long-term vision and periodization of training and racing to optimize athlete development and performance
- Collaborate with the Integrated Support Team to design, implement and monitor yearly training plans, optimal athlete preparations (including strength and conditioning, mental performance, health, nutrition) and competition plans for Senior NST athletes
- Collaborate with the technical support team, including on ski selection and ski preparation
- Foster core team values and excellence behaviours, mentor athletes and collaborate with associated DTE coaches
- Plan and lead training camps and competition tours
- Driven by the Gold Medal Profile, ensure alignment of Senior NST and feeder high performance programs through common strategies in the daily training environment and identify and implement systematic links between plans
- Identify key initiatives and strategies to maximize sustainable performance of Canadian athletes at the international level
- Collaborate with high performance team members to establish annual performance benchmarks for athletes and programs and provide reports and program evaluation for the Senior NST and other NST program activities to ensure program development and facilitate goal attainment

## **Requirements**

- University degree is sport sciences or related field or equivalent
- Coaching certification: Level 4 certified/CCD certified + CDAG trained **and/or** Level 5 certified/CDAG certified **or** equivalent.
- Proven ability to inspire and mentor coaches and athletes within the national high performance network and to deliver and integrate the key components of a high performance program
- Success leading teams of athletes, coaches and support staff at major international competitions
- Strong understanding of Nordiq Canada, Olympic sport and the Canadian sport system
- Leadership skills to develop and contribute to the development of a high performance team and to build strong relationships and credibility with athletes, coaches and support staff
- French-English bilingualism is an asset

## **Skills and Competencies**

- The ability to inspire and align many stakeholders to a common vision and plan through outstanding communication, leadership and change management processes
