## Introduction

COVID-19 has introduced a great deal of uncertainty. This document will guide Nordiq Canada on how and when to respond to ever-changing risks and opportunities related to COVID-19. By using this document, Nordiq Canada expects to be prepared to act quickly no matter the situation. Divisions and clubs can also use this document to know what they can expect from Nordiq Canada.

This is a high-level, working document that will be updated as required. The document will be reviewed weekly to determine if actions are required. Megan Begley and Kate Boyd have overall responsibility for this document. Staff members are encourgaged to review the document regularly. Program areas will develop detailed plans and tools stemming from this document.

Nordiq Canada's top priority is the health of its members and staff. We will follow directives issued by the Government of Canada and other relevant agencies, and we will do what is required to support Canada's public health interests. We will continue to work with our sport and medical partners (e.g., OTP task force, Sport Medicine Advisory Committee) in determining and reducing risk.

Under all scenarios, we remain guided by our long-term goals. We understand the importance of sustaining individual members, clubs and Divisions over the long term.
