

2021-22 Competition Trip Team Selection and Synopsis

World Cup P1

The following athletes have been selected to participate in the World Cup for Period 1, as per the *Competition Trip Criteria 2021-2022* document. The Team of four (4) women and four (4) men will depart Canada November 18 to compete in races in Finland, Norway, Switzerland, and Germany.

Competition Trip 2021-22 selection criteria 4.5 World Cup Period 1:

- a. **COC Leaders:** No COC races have been held in Canada in the past year, therefore no Canadian athletes can currently hold the title of COC leader as per FIS rules.
- b. **Athletes who have met partial OWG qualification criteria in the 2020-21 season are selected in order of priority criteria achieved:**
 - Graham Ritchie (OWG criteria 5.C.12 – 17th Ulricehamn WC sprint)
 - Dahria Beatty (OWG criteria 5.C.13 - 15th Engadin WC mass start)
 - Katherine Stewart-Jones (OWG criteria 5.C.13 - 17th Falun WC mass start)
 - Maya MacIsaac-Jones (OWG criteria 5.C.13 - 18th Ulricehamn WC sprint)
 - Olivier Léveillé (OWG criteria 5.C.15 - 3rd WJR 10k skate)
- c. **Athletes who achieved World Cup individual points in the 2020-21 season are selected:**
 - Cendrine Browne (Lahti and Falun WC, 12 pts)
 - Antoine Cyr (Engadin WC, 12 pts)
 - Russell Kennedy (Lahti and Falun WC, 4 pts)
